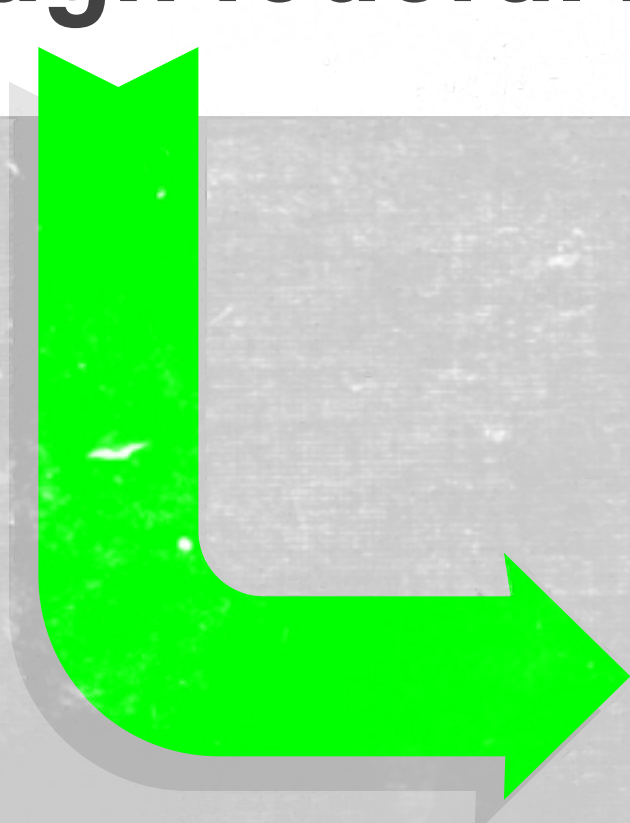
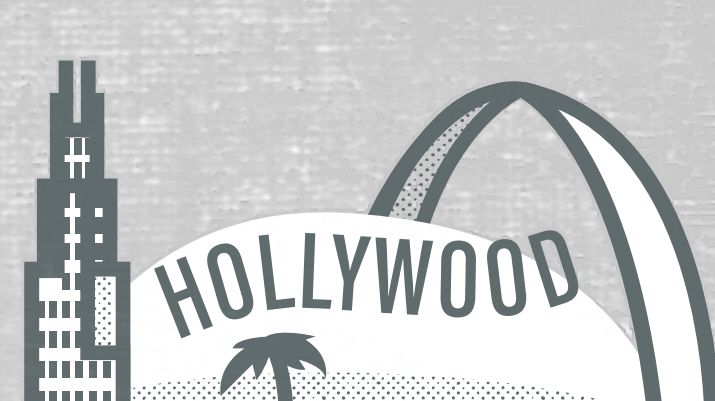


HYDE HURTS!

The Hyde Amendment prohibits coverage of abortion care through federal health insurance programs such as Medicaid.



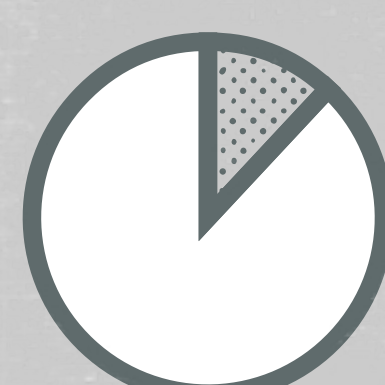
HOW MANY IS

It's more than the entire population of Arizona



It's about 12% of ALL women aged 15–44 in the United States
